

Mindset Neuroscience Training transforms the way teachers interact with students – for the long term – by training educators in a replicable method that creates buy-in to integrate updated brain science into classrooms, staff development and moment-to-moment interactions between staff, students and personal relationships. Through experiential and self-reflection exercises, educators learn how to improve their ability to connect with their students and create activities and conditions that optimize the human brain for learning.

Teachers created 'peace corners' for students, routines for meditation and mindfulness and reported improved behavior among students.
Horizon Science Academy	School-wide, full-day training devoted to Growth Mindset, Executive Functioning and Self-Regulation	As a result of the training, teachers initiated a Professional Learning Community devoted to Growth Mindset. PLC members incorporated brain-science backed criteria into their classrooms and developed lesson plans focused on celebrating mistakes and learning about the brain.
Enlace Chicago	Custom professional development two-day training focused on social and emotional learning and growth mindset - for parent educators (staff who lead workshops for parents).	Parent educators took material and curriculum from training and developed and delivered their own workshops for parents and teachers at several schools.
